## Tisbury School (4029) Enrolment Scheme

Effective from Day Month Year

The guidelines for development and operation of enrolment schemes are issued under Schedule 20, Clause 3 (3) of the Education and Training Act 2020 for the purpose of describing the basis on which the Secretary's powers in relation to enrolment schemes will be exercised.

## **Home Zone**

All students who live within the home zone described below shall be eligible to enrol at the school.

The Home Zone takes addresses on both sides of the boundary roads mentioned in the description unless otherwise stated.

Starting from the intersection of Scott Street and Boxall Street, the home zone follows:

- East along Boxall Street until McMillan Street
- North along McMillan Street until Tramway Road
- East along the southern side of Tramway Road until Rockdale Road
- North along Rockdale Road until Mason Road
- East along Mason Road until Kennington Waimatua Road
- South along Kennington Waimatua Road until Orr Road
- East along Orr Road until the end of Orr Road
  - o Including Blondell Road between Orr Road and Nally Road
- From the end of Orr Road jumps east to the intersection of Longbush South Road and Tapper Road
- South along Longbush South Road until Welsh Road
  - o Including Longbush South Road to the south of Welsh Road,
  - And including Masseys Tramway Road to the west of Longbush South Road
- West along Welsh Road until Motu Rimu Road
- South then west along Motu Rimu Road until Tiwai Road
  - o Including Wilson Road South and all side streets off of it
- South-east along Tiwai Road until Awarua Bay Road
  - o Including Awaura School Road,
  - o Including Mackay Road,
  - o Including Hall Road,
  - And including Tiwai Road to the south of Awarua Bay Road up to number 1044
- South then east along Awarua Bay Road until the end of Awarua Bay Road
  - Including Buddle Road
- West back along Awarua Bay Road until Tiwai Road
- North back along Tiwai Road until Awarua School Road
- South-west along Awarua School Road until Colver Road
- North-west along Colyer Road until Bluff Highway (SH 1)
  - o Including Colyer Road to the south of Awarua School Road,
  - o Including Garret Road,
  - And including Awarua Siding Road South
- North-east along Bluff Highway (SH 1) until Bay View Road

- o Including Kekeno Place,
- And including Bluff Highway (SH 1) to the north of Bayview Road down to and including number 768 Bluff highway
- North-east along Bay view Road until Boundary Road
  - Including all the side streets off Bay View Road between Bluff highwau (SH 1) and Boundary Road
- North along Boundary Road until Avon Road
- West along Avon Road until Walker Street
  - o Including Perkins Street to the south of Avon Road
- South along Walker Street until Ferguson Street
- North-west along Ferguson Street until its intersection with Avon Road and Chesney Street
- North along Chesney Street until Scott Street
- South-east along Scott Street until Boxall Street

## **Special Programmes**

This priority category is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a Special programme approved by the Secretary.

## **Out of Zone Enrolments**

Each year the Board of Trustees will determine the number of places which are likely to be available in the following year for the enrolment of students who live outside the home zone. The Board will publish this information by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. The notice will indicate how applications are to be made and will specify a date by which all applications must be received.

Applications for enrolments will be processed in the following order of priority:

First Priority This priority is not applicable at this school because the school

does not run a special programme approved by the Secretary

for Education.

**Second Priority** will be given to applicants who are siblings of current

students.

**Third Priority** will be given to applicants who are siblings of former students.

Fourth Priority will be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student

of the school.

Fifth Priority will be given to any applicant who is either a child of an

employee of the board of the school or a child of a member of

the board of the school.

**Sixth Priority** will be given to all other applicants.

If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth, fifth or sixth priority groups than there are places available, Selection within the priority group will be by ballot conducted in accordance with instructions by the Secretary, under Schedule 20, Clause 3 (1) of the Education and Training Act 2020. Parents will be informed of the

date of any ballot by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school.

Applicants seeking second or third priority status may be required to give proof of a sibling relationship.
